Subject: Revision of Misdeclaration Fee and Weight Deviation

Please be informed that the Misdeclaration Fee applicable to general cargoes and the acceptable weight deviation criteria have been revised in line with market practices.

The revision is implemented to strengthen compliance and mitigate risks arising from inaccurate cargo declarations, including potential customs penalties, operational disruptions, and safety concerns.

1. The misdeclaration fee for general cargo has been revised to **USD 5,000 per unit**, applicable in cases of cargo misdeclaration.
2. Any difference between the declared VGM and/or Bill of Lading weight and the verified actual weight **exceeding 3 metric tons** will be considered a weight misdeclaration.

The above changes are effective immediately.

Customers are requested to ensure that all cargo descriptions, shipment details, and declared weights provided to ESL are accurate and complete to avoid potential additional charges, delays, or regulatory implications.

ESL reserves the right to request additional information, verify shipment details, reject bookings, or decline cargo acceptance where cargo information is incomplete, inaccurate, or requires further verification. Where a cargo misdeclaration is identified, ESL further reserves the right to recover all associated costs, liabilities, penalties, damages, and applicable Line Administration Fees.
